*The 'schwa' sound is a neutral vowel sound that sounds like an /uh/ or /eh/, depending on your dialect and the word. The schwa sound can be represented by unstressed vowel graphemes such as 'a' in 'about' or 'o' in 'carrot'.

Note: The closest written representation of phonemes using the English Roman alphabet have been used in the *Snappy Sounds* resources. The International Phonetic Alphabet (IPA) is the *most accurate* written representation of phonemes.
