---

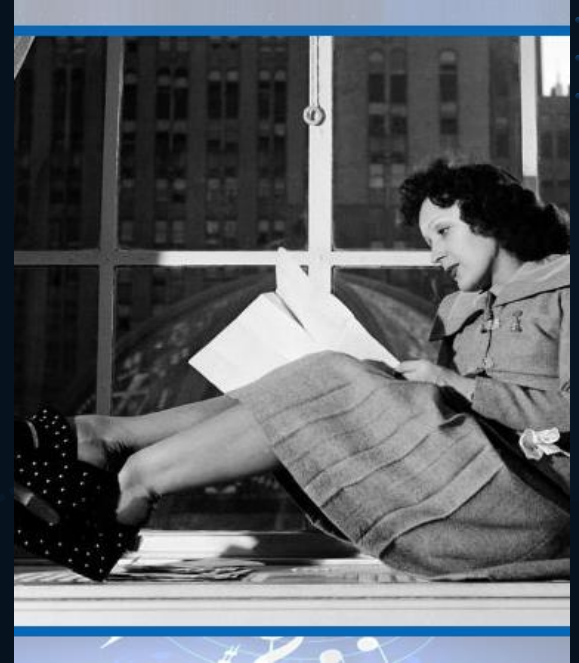
